Container	Description/examples
	<p>Yellow canister</p> <p>non halogenated solvents (non chlorinated)</p> <p>e.g., acetone, ethanol, diethyl ether, hexane, methanol, toluene, xylene, alcohols, petrol, petroleum ether etc. Mixed, non halogenated solvents</p> <p>Important: returnable only with address label on the side</p>
	<p>Blue canister</p> <p>halogenated solvents (chlorinated)</p> <p>e.g., chloroform, dichlormethane, trichlorethylene, etc. Mixed, chlorinated solvents</p> <p>Important: returnable only with address label on the side</p>
	<p>White canister</p> <p>toxic waste</p> <p>e.g., used oil, heavy metals, cyanide, acids not mixed etc. (mix different wastes only if compatible, otherwise one waste or acid per canister)</p> <p>Important: returnable only with address label on the side and attached duly completed brown label "Sonderabfälle"</p>
	<p>White bucket</p> <p>toxic waste</p> <p>e.g., not reactive solid chemicals, solid and liquid chemicals in original bottles/boxes (mix different wastes only if compatible, otherwise one waste per bucket)</p> <p>Important: returnable only with address label on the side and attached duly completed brown label "Sonderabfälle"</p>
	<p>Blue disposal box</p> <p>toxic waste</p> <p>e.g., radiochemicals and reactive organic and inorganic chemical waste. (mix different wastes only if compatible, otherwise one waste per box)</p> <p>Important: returnable only with address label on the side and attached duly completed brown label "Sonderabfälle"</p>
